

Popcorn Garland



In the book, Bear and his friends string popcorn to decorate their tree. Pop according to your air popper directions, or the directions on the the bag of popcorn.

Next, thread a needle. It's best to double up your thread, so measure a piece twice as long as your final garland. It's easiest to work with 4 or 5 feet. If you're making a five foot garland, you should measure out 10 feet of thread.

Take your thread and pull it halfway through the needle so you will have two segments of the same length on each side. Tie a knot at the end.

Start adding popcorn by poking the center of the popcorn, press it through, and slide the popcorn to the end of your string. Continue this process until your string is full of popcorn. Then, tie a knot at the end of your string.

Snack on the popcorn while making your garland!
